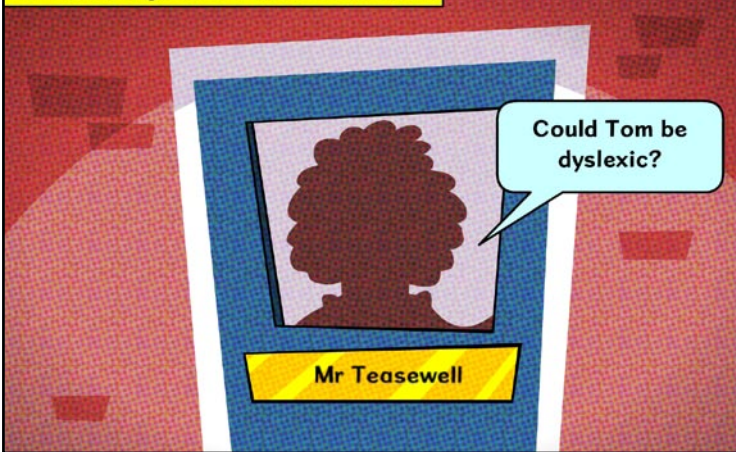


Tom is left handed which makes him smudge the wet ink.





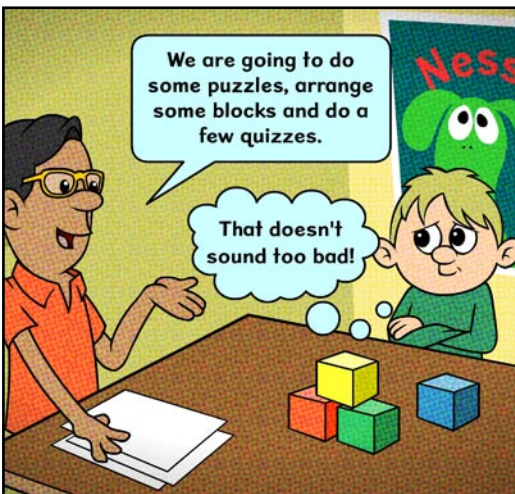

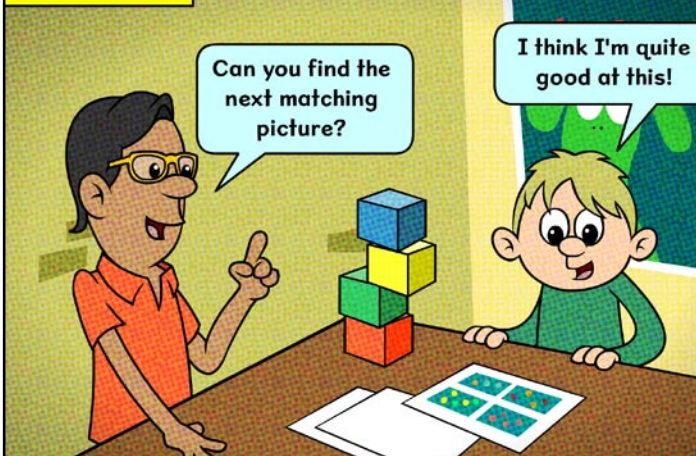

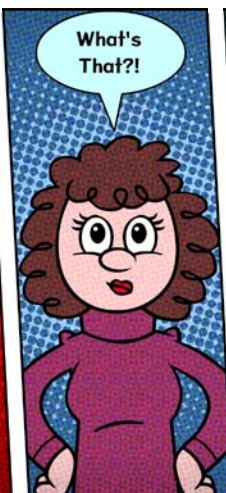
